YORKSHIRE WILDLIFE PARK

On Tuesday, 28th November 2017 children from KS1 will be going to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park. The trip will be led by Miss McDermott accompanied by Miss Shelton, Mrs Sprague and 10 accompanying adults. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling by Gordons Coaches. The coach will depart school around 9:15 and return at approx. 14:45

This trip is for us to enhance our learning about animals alongside our topic and to get first-hand experience of seeing the animals in real life.

The cost of this trip including an animal workshop and insurance will be **£15.00**. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. The contribution is genuinely voluntary and no parent/carer is under any obligation to pay and no pupils at the school will be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution in response to the request.
