## Standedge Tunnel, Marsden

On Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, your child will be going to Standedge Tunnel Visitor Centre, Marsden. The trip will be led by Miss Stevens, accompanied by Mrs. Sharp and five other adults. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling by Marsdens Coaches. The coach will depart school around 9:15am and return by 3.15pm.

The purpose of this trip is to provide the children with an exciting experience of canal and river life. This visit will expand their knowledge of our 'Rivers' topic' and give first hand and practical experiences. Children will take part in a workshop where they will construct model canals. Also included in the visit will be a ride into Standedge tunnel in a glass topped boat.

The cost of the trip is **£15 which will need to be paid via your on line Parent Pay account**. This includes travel and insurance, the workshop (led by the Canals and Rivers Trust), a boat ride, study time in the exhibition centre and a small gift bag. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquires will be treated confidentially. This request is for a voluntary contribution and in no way represents a charge. The contribution is genuinely voluntary and no parent/carer is under any obligation to pay and no pupils at the school will be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution in response to the request. However, if insufficient contributions are forthcoming then the trip may have to be cancelled.

Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support.

Children will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles, fizzy pop or chocolate please). If your child would like to order a school sandwich or is entitled to a free school meal please complete the reply slip.

Uniform should be worn along with suitable clothing for the weather including sensible footwear. If your child is on medication, inhalers etc, please send this labelled to your child's class teacher.
