Macbeth at Rose Theatre in York

On Thursday 12th July, children from Year 5 have been offered the opportunity to watch Macbeth performed at the Rose Theatre in York. The trip will be led by Miss Connell accompanied by Mr Flanagan and four accompanying adults. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling by Expressway Coaches. The coach will depart school at around 9:00am and we will aim to be back at school at around 6:00pm depending on the traffic.

The cost of this trip and insurance will be £8.94 which will need to be paid via your online Parent Pay account. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquires will be treated confidentially. This request is for a voluntary contribution and in no way represents a charge. The contribution is genuinely voluntary and no parent/carer is under any obligation to pay and no pupils at the school will be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution in response to the request. However, if insufficient contributions are forthcoming then the trip may have to be cancelled.

Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support. This is an incredible opportunity for children. The Rose Theatre is only available for a limited time and it is based on The Globe Theatre in London, which Shakespeare helped build himself.

Children will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles, fizzy pop or chocolate please) and a snack for later on in the day. If your child would like to order a school sandwich or is entitled to a free school meal please complete the reply slip. School will only be able to provide one lunch.

Uniform should be worn along with suitable clothing for the weather including sensible footwear. If your child is on medication, inhalers etc, please send this labelled to your child's class teacher.

School expects children to behave in an appropriate, sensible manner and to follow the school code of conduct at all times. We reserve the right to refuse access to the visit for children who do not meet the acceptable criteria. If you are happy for your son/daughter to go on this visit, please complete the slip below and return it to their class teacher.
