For all children in our setting we aim to positively promote good behaviour. By valuing a co-operative and caring attitude we hope to ensure that children will develop as reasonable members of society. Through promoting this positive behaviour, beginning with our youngest of learners, we aim to encourage self-discipline and consideration for each other, our surroundings and property. We strive to encourage positive behaviour by:

- * Praising and reinforcing good behaviour
- * Encouraging sharing and negotiation
- * Being positive role models
- * Setting good examples
- * Consulting children about rules and boundaries
- * Helping children to understand the effects of their behaviour on others (at an appropriate level)
- * Encouraging responsibility
- * Helping children to challenge negative behaviour in other.

As a school, we believe that if our children are able to practice and carry out appropriate behaviour from the earliest point, with the support of the above tools, the need for behaviour sanctions should hopefully decrease. However for exceptional circumstances strategies are in place to support and achieve learners in making the correct behavioural choices.
