On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019, children from 1B, 1/2K and 2RF will be going to Manchester Airport Educational Centre. The trip will be led by Miss Bullivant and the KS1 staff. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling with Expressway Coaches. The coach will depart school around 8:45am (arrival at school at 8.25am) and return at 3.00pm.

The purpose of this trip is to provide the children with an exciting experience of an actual airport whilst expanding their knowledge of flying, the history of flight and bringing their in – school learning to life. The children will also complete learning linked to our trip when we return.

The cost of this trip including an exciting workshop, farm tour and insurance will be **£16.00**. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquires will be treated confidentially **ALL payments must be made through Paypoint**. This request is for a voluntary contribution and in no way represents a charge. The contribution is genuinely voluntary and no parent/carer is under any obligation to pay and no pupils at the school will be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution in response to the request. However, if insufficient contributions are forthcoming then the trip may have to be cancelled.

Children will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles, fizzy pop or chocolate please).
