On Monday 10th June, children from 3/4 K and 4H will be going to RSPB Old Moor Nature Reserve. This wonderful opportunity will give children the chance to go pond dipping, learn more about varied habitats, and go birdwatching in the special hides using real binoculars!

The trip will be led by Mrs Kane, Miss Hibberd and accompanying adults. The coach will depart school around 9:15am and return at 2:50pm.

The purpose of this trip is to explore different habitats, develop environmental knowledge and learn more about local wildlife.

The cost of this trip, including the two exciting workshops led by RSPB experts, will be £13.00. This includes travel and insurance as well as the charge for Old Moor. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquires will be treated confidentially. This request is for a voluntary contribution and no parent/carer is under any obligation to pay. No pupils at the school will be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have made any contribution. However, if insufficient contributions are forthcoming then the trip may have to be cancelled.

Children will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or chocolate please). If your child would like to order a school sandwich or is entitled to a free school meal please let us know.

Uniform should be worn along with suitable clothing for the weather, including sensible footwear. If your child is on medication, inhalers etc, please send this labelled to your child's class teacher.

School expects children to behave in an appropriate, sensible manner and to follow the Whitehill Way at all times. If you are happy for your son/daughter to go on this visit, please give permission and make your payment via Parentpay.
