Outdoor Adventure Activity

On Thursday 16th May, The Y6 children will be taking part in an Outdoor Adventure Activity at Ulley Reservoir as a reward after finishing the KS2 SATs. The trip will be led by Mrs Jones and accompanied by Mrs Dobson, Mrs Knight, Mrs Hanson and Mr Kerry. All local authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling by Rawmarsh Community School mini-bus. The mini buses will be leaving as soon as the last test has been completed: it will be around 11am.

Our exciting activities will include canoeing, sailing and kayaking.

This is an outdoor activity and children will be required to bring:

- Sensible clothing suitable for the activity. Loose fitting clothes, tracksuit bottoms, long sleeve top and old trainers. Children must come to school dressed in their uniform with their clothes in a bag to change in to.
- Coat, hat, scarf and gloves (if it is cold)
- Waterproofs if they have them (please do not go out and buy them.)
- Towel (just in case they get wet/splashed.)
- Packed lunch (we will be having a picnic at Ulley.)

The cost for the trip will be paid for by the school.

Please be aware that this visit is weather dependent and may have to be cancelled on the day.

Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support.
