Outdoor Adventure Activity

On Friday 13th September we will be taking part in an Outdoor Adventure Activity at Ulley Reservoir. The trip will be led by Mrs Dobson and accompanied by 2 other adults. All local authority risk assessments have been completed and children will be fitted with a buoyancy aid checked by a qualified instructor. All activities are suitable for non-swimmers. The children will be travelling by Rawmarsh Community School mini-bus. The coach will depart school at 9:15am and return around 11:30am.

All activities are water based and may include canoeing, sailing, kayaking or rafting.

This is an outdoor water based activity and children will be required to bring:

- Sensible clothing suitable for the activity. Loose fitting clothes, tracksuit bottoms, long sleeve top and old trainers. Children must come to school dressed in their clothes for the activity with their uniform in a bag to change in to.
- Coat, hat, scarf and gloves
- Waterproofs if they have them (please do not go out and buy them.)
- Towel (just in case they enter the water.)
- Packed lunch (we will be having a picnic at Ulley.)

The cost for the trip is £3.00 and should be paid via Parentpay. Consent must be given via Parentpay.

Please be aware that this visit is weather dependent and may have to be cancelled on the day.

Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support.

School expects children to behave in an appropriate, sensible manner and to follow the school code of conduct at all times. We reserve the right to refuse access to the visit for children who do not meet the acceptable criteria. If you are happy for your son/daughter to go on the visit, please complete the slip attached and return it to school.
