Using 10 lolly sticks, write one number on each stick (1-10). Can you put the corresponding number of rubber bands or hair ties onto the stick. Can you then wrap them around the bottom of the stick.

Write simple CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words on pieces of paper (such as cat, dog, man). Put them in a hat. Choose a CVC word and come up with a word that rhymes.

Gather a group of toys. Can you measure each toy using paperclips. Then can you measure each toy using your foot. Talk about why the answers are different. Then can you put the toys in order from biggest to smallest. Create a name puzzle. Write your name on a piece of paper, then cut the letters apart. Can you put the letters back in the correct order to spell your name. You can also do this with names of friends and family members.

Can you roll a die. Then build a block tower with as many blocks as the number on the die. For a challenge, roll two dice, add the numbers together, and then build!

Use scrap paper to draw 2D shapes. Then cut those shapes out.

Using plastic cups, can you try to stack the cups as high as you can.

Go outside with a cup of water and a paintbrush. What can you paint?
