Go on a Math Scavenger Hunt! Can you label a piece of paper with numbers 1-10. Go outside and look for groups of objects that are together (Example: 1 car, 2 trees, 3 flowers, etc). Can you draw or write them on your paper. Can you make a hopscotch outside with chalk. You can fill the board with numbers, shapes, letters, CVC words, or colours. Can you say them as you jump on each square? Fill a large container with water. Can you gather a variety of different objects. Then place each one inside the container to see if it sinks or floats. Can you think of why this might happen?

Create simple CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words using a muffin tin. Can you put magnetic letters into the tin to create words (such as cat, man, dog, etc).

Make a fort out of pillows, blankets, cushions, and whatever else you can think of! Then read books in your fort. You could use a torch for extra fun.
