KS1 Trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park

On Tuesday 14th March 2023, children from KS1 will be going to Yorkshire Wildlife Park. The trip will be led by Mrs Ross, Miss Beevers, Mrs Sharp and the KS1 staff. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling via Expressway Coaches. The coach will depart school around 9:15am and return at 3:00pm.

The purpose of this trip is to provide the children with the exciting experience of visiting the Yorkshire Wildlife Park whilst expanding their knowledge of our Science topic about animals and their habitats. The trip includes a workshop called "Bear Necessities" where children will learn all about the polar bear's arctic habitat.
