Sensory circuits are an ideal way to energise a child or settle a child ready to learn and engage with the school day. Trials of Sensory Circuits for Y6 classes during SATs week have proven successful in supporting children to feel calm and focused with the exams ahead, they also support to ease anxiety and support with emotional regulation. 






Mrs Ross attended some training at Abbey School around identifying different types of SEND and how to manage these effectively in a PE setting.
