### KS1 Trip to Wentworth Woodhouse

On Tuesday 5th November 2024, children from KS1 will be going to Wentworth Woodhouse. The trip will be led by Mrs Sharp, Miss Hollingworth and Miss Barnes and the KS1 staff. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling via Expressways Coaches. The coach will depart school around 9:15am (children must arrive at school for the usual time) and return at 2:30.

The purpose of this trip is to provide the children with the exciting experience of visiting a different village where they can compare the human and physical features to the ones of Brinsworth, developing their knowledge and skills as geographers.

As this is an enrichment activity, in order for these activities to take place, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £11.40. All payment is at the discretion of parents/carers and any contribution will be viewed as voluntary. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquiries will be treated confidentially **ALL payments must be made through Parent Pay**. However, if insufficient contributions are forthcoming then the trip may have to be cancelled.

Children will need a packed lunch including a drink (no glass bottles, fizzy drink or chocolate please). If your child would like to order a school sandwich or is entitled to a free school meal please complete the online form which will be included in the email with this letter.

Uniform should be worn along with suitable clothing for the weather. As the children will be outside for most of the day, they will need coats, suitable footwear and a bag suitable to carry lunch and water bottles.

School expects children to behave in an appropriate, sensible manner and to follow the school code of conduct at all times. We reserve the right to refuse access to the visit for children who do not meet the acceptable criteria. If you are happy for your son/daughter to go on this visit, please give your permission via Parentpay.
