**FS2 Cannon Hall Farm Visit**

Children will be travelling by Wickersley Partnership Trust minibuses. The minibuses will depart school around 9:25 am and return at approximately 2:45pm. Please arrive at school for 8:45am. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed.

As this is an enrichment activity, in order for these activities to take place, we ask for a voluntary contribution of £12.95. This contribution includes admission and transport. All payment is at the discretion of parents/carers and any contribution will be viewed as voluntary. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquiries will be treated confidentially. ALL payments must be made through Parent Pay. However, in the event of an inadequate number of contributions being received, it will not be possible for the visit to take place. In the event of a visit being cancelled at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances, it may not be possible to refund any contributions.

Children are expected to wear suitable clothing for the weather including sensible footwear and school jumper or cardigan.

All children in Foundation Stage are entitled to universal free school meals. If you would like to order a school sandwich for this trip please fill in the google form.
