Y3/4 Trip to Treak Cliff Cavern

On Tuesday 30th September 2025, children from Year 3 and 4 will be visiting Treak Cliff Cavern. The trip will be led by Mrs Hanson, Ms Holmes, Miss Wakenshaw and the Y3/4 staff. All Local Authority risk assessments have been completed. The children will be travelling via Johnson Bros Coaches. The coach will depart school at 9am and return at approximately 3pm.

As the children are learning about The Peak District this term, this trip will deepen their knowledge and understanding of the human and physical features of The Peak District and will put their learning in context. Treak Cliff Cavern is famous throughout the world for its unique beautiful cave formations. We will be visiting the caves and then completing field work activities in the local area. Outings are enjoyable and a very valuable educational experience and we thank you for your support.

The cost of this trip will be £17.80. This trip has been subsidised by school. Please contact the school office if you have any questions regarding payment. All enquires will be treated confidentially **ALL payments and consent must be made through Parent Pay**. This request is for a voluntary contribution and in no way represents a charge.
